TERMS & CONDITIONS FOR APPRENTICESHIP TRAINING:

1	All the qualifications must be from Indian Institutions recognized by the Appropriate Statutory Authority.
2	Registration of Graduate/Diploma Candidates should be made on www.mhrdnats.gov.in
3	Regular Candidates who have completed their educational qualifications in 2022, 2023, 2024, 2025 & 2026 are eligible to attend the walk-in selections.
4	Candidates who have already undergone Apprenticeship Training or are currently undergoing Apprenticeship Training under any organisation are not eligible to attend the walk-in selections.
5	Candidates with more than one year of work experience are not eligible to attend the walk-in selections
6	Candidates should be at least 18 years of age as on the date of selection.
7	The tenure of Apprenticeship Training for the above trades would be 12 months, commencing from the execution of the Contract of Apprenticeship. IIT Tirupati may engage them as Institute Trainees for another one year, based on the Institute's requirement/vacancy for such trainees, the suitability/performance of the candidates & mutual consent.
8	No TA/DA will be paid to the applicants called for any stage of the selection process.
9	The engagement and training are strictly in compliance with the provisions of the Apprenticeship Act 1961, and there is no obligation to employ apprentices upon completion of their training.
10	The apprentice should be willing to work on different shifts. Hostel may be provided within the IIT Tirupati campus on a payment basis, subject to availability.
11	Transportation may not be provided by the establishment during the training period.
12	Selection will be made on the basis of Academic Merit/Written Test/Interaction as required, subject to satisfactory verification of the documents.
13	Any canvassing or personal follow-up intended to influence the selection process for an apprentice, by or on behalf of any candidate, shall lead to the immediate cancellation of candidature.
14	IIT Tirupati reserves all the rights to withdraw/cancel the advertisement/selection process if circumstances so warrant without assigning any reason thereof.
15	The number of apprentices mentioned above is only indicative and may change at a later stage, depending on the final assessment of eligible applications received.
16	Suppression of facts will lead to disqualification at any stage of the selection process or during the training period.

INSTRUCTIONS FOR THE CANDIDATES

1.	Before attending the selection process, candidates shall ensure that they fulfil all the eligibility criteria and other norms mentioned in the advertisement
2.	Step I: NATS Registration. Link for NATS Registration: National Apprenticeship Training Scheme (NATS) : (https://nats.education.gov.in/student_register.php)
3.	Bring the duly filled application as per (Annexures A) along with self-certified Educational Certificates & Marks Sheets, a valid Category Certificate (if applicable), and an Experience Certificate, if any, PwD Certificate, if applicable, at the time of selection Note: A candidate eligible for more than one position must submit a separate application for each eligible post.
4.	Candidates are requested to enter the correct details in all fields of the application form and to provide the supporting documents.
5.	The marks obtained in the qualifying exam are to be mentioned in percentage. For CGPA, candidates are requested to convert it to a percentage as per their university norms, and the same will be verified during document verification.
6.	Verification of credentials shall be conducted for the selected candidates prior to the creation of the Contract, and in the event of any deviation from or non-conformity with the desired qualifications, the candidature of the candidate shall be summarily rejected.
7.	All applicants are required to bring self-attested copies of documents mentioned below, along with the duly filled application form, during document verification. <u>Documents to be carried:</u> (a) 10 th Mark sheet and Certificate (b) Graduation/Diploma Mark sheets for all semesters (c) Degree/Provisional Degree/Diploma Certificates (d) Category Certificate, if applicable (e) PWD Certificate, if applicable (f) EWS Certificate, if applicable (g) Any photo identity card issued by the Govt of India, such as PAN card, Voter card, or Driving License. (h) Aadhaar Card and a copy of the Bank Passbook (i) Medical Fitness Certificate issued by a Civil Surgeon or equivalent (j) Two passport-sized photographs
8.	No correspondence shall be entertained from the candidates not selected for training.
9.	Selected candidates for certificate verification will be informed via the email ID mentioned in the application form. Selected candidates shall have to sign a contract on the date of joining as per Govt of India rules.
10.	Candidates finally selected will have to produce a valid Police Verification Certificate either from their Place of last residence (for at least the past one year) or permanent address at the time of joining.
11.	In case of any dispute, the legal jurisdiction shall be that of the Honorable High Court, Amaravati, Andhra Pradesh.
